1) Please consider the original timeline and deliverable targets. How is your project progressing compared with the original estimates?

We are basically on target. At RCC we ran a number of ENG 101 098 classes that employed ePortfolios to enhance student learning. With the help of our IR Department during the next several weeks we will be analyzing the results of these classes compared to classes which did not employ ePortfolios. This will give us preliminary data which will be useful as we continue the project in classes during the spring semester. We have been working collaboratively with SUNY Sullivan; they have identified a project coordinator and faculty who will be testing ePorfolios in their accelerated writing classes during the spring. We submitted a proposal to CIT to present a poster at the May conference, describing our activities and results.

Although we were approved for the project during the summer of 2014, we did not receive funding until mid-November. We have been proceeding with grant activities as best we can as a community college.

We haven't encountered any roadblocks other than the delay in receiving funding.

It is has been significant that this collaboration began during the planning process for the grant.
