Research (Erickson, Lee, & von Schrader, 2015) shows that there is a substantial gap in educational attainment between 18-64 years old with and without disabilities. There is a 19% difference in bachelor degree attainment. Also, an estimated 28.2% percent of those 21 to 64 years with a disability in the United States were living below the poverty line, compared to 12.5% for those without a disability. Providing educators with training in developing educational experiences of which all students are able to take advantage is crucial in closing the gap between education and poverty levels of people with and without disabilities.

A large amount of the faculty and staff time was in-kind from the participating institutions, totaling approximately+ \$42,500.
