Yes, our program allowed for the adoption and remixing of OERs across 8 courses. Through the adoption process, instructors dropped costly textbooks saving each student an average of \$124 per course. A preliminary potential savings of \$30,320 for the Fall 2018 semester.

The project supported course access, affordability, and choice. For example the OERs allow for immediate access to the content, cost savings for the students, and choice for student (they can decide if they want a printed version of OER at low-cost).
