
SUNY's Online Education Footprint

- SUNY has courses/programs in every programmatic area
 - many available online
 - 900+ online programs from 55 campuses
 - 36,991 course sections online in AY22/23; 25,890 in AY19/20
 - 11,153 hybrid or hyflex courses in AY22/23
- Deep experience serving students with online offerings going back to 1994
 - 56,742 fully online learners across SUNY in Fall 2022; 30,958 in Fall 2019
 - 101,977 students took one or more online course in Fall 2022; 65,541 in Fall 2019
 - 7,769 faculty taught online in Fall 2022; 4,588 in Fall 2019






Fall Enrollments by Online Status






Fall 2022 Course Sections by Online Status








SUNY Online Help Desk Stats, 2023




